

Dial A – This should be set to the water and heating option as shown below.



Dial B - This is the water temperature control and should be set near to "Max" as shown below.




Dial C - This is the central heating control and should be set to the "dot" which is optimum setting as shown below.



Dial G – This is the timer unit dial and can be set to "off", "timer" or "constant"



Boiler Timer Instructions are as follows:



The table below shows the codes on the display and their meanings.

DISPLAY CODE ON BOILER	DESCRIPTION
O School	The boiler is in standby mode awaiting either a central heating call or hot water demand.
L proper	The boiler has a call for central heating but the appliance has reached the desired temperature set on the boiler.
d	The boiler has a call for hot water but the appliance has reached the desired temperature set on the boiler.
C O	The boiler is operating in central heating mode.
d O	The boiler is operating in hot water mode.
P. O	The boiler is operating in pre heat mode.
F 0	The water in the cental heating circuit is less than 5°C. If heating is switched on, this display code will change to "c".
